At the request of the office of Los Angeles Mayor Antonio Villaraigosa, Los Angeles Councilmember Bill Rosendahl, City of Inglewood Mayor Roosevelt Dorn, and City of El Segundo Mayor Kelly McDowell, Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) is revising the content for the community meetings scheduled for Wednesday October 25 and Saturday October 28. Airfield safety is an important and complicated issue; therefore, a meeting dedicated solely to this topic was deemed necessary as part of the community-based planning process.

We understand that the public has a broad interest in learning more about airfield safety in general and the nature and composition of runway incursions in particular. At these public meetings, the Federal Aviation Administration and LAWA will provide a detailed presentation on safety issues on both the north and south airfields. The public will have an opportunity to ask questions of these experts at these meetings. The information to be presented will be the same at both the Wednesday and Saturday meetings.
